


Milestone Early Years Home Activities 'Weather' Term 2

We'll have fun building a den and collecting leaves in the Forest Area – what will we need?


Physical Development

Inside we are using lots of Clever Finger activities:- using tweezers to pick up pompoms, playdough and lots of other tricky things for our fingers.


Topic Story Two

Topic Story 3
