Overview

How accessible is our website?

This website is **not fully** compliant with the [Web Content Accessibility Guidelines version 2.1](#) AA standard.

On our website, you should be able to

- change colours, contrast levels and fonts
- zoom in up to 200% without the text spilling off the screen
- navigate most of the website using just a keyboard
- navigate most of the website using speech recognition software
- listen to most of the website using a screen reader (including the most recent versions of JAWS, NVDA and VoiceOver)

- All images have alt text

We know some parts of our website are **not fully accessible** at the moment:

- some PDFs on this site are not accessible
- pinch-to-zoom doesn't work on most android mobile devices
- some text elements don't have sufficient contrast
- the main navigation is not in a list format on desktop
- Navigation is not marked as a list
